### **ACCREDITATION**

The GGSB MIB (Master in International Business) programme from the Grenoble Ecole de Management - Grenoble Graduate School of Business, is a programme designed for high-potential students progressing straight from university, with little (typically up to 3 years) or no work experience.

The GGSB MIB is offered at GISMA Business School in Berlin. The programme is delivered and awarded by the triple-accredited\* Grenoble Graduate School of Business (GGSB), an honour shared by less than 1% of the world's elite business schools. GGSB's triple accreditation includes: AMBA, EQUIS and AACSB.

\*AMBA (Association of MBAs), EQUIS (European Quality Improvement System), AACSB (Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business).

#### RANKING

The GGSB MIB was ranked 20th worldwide in "Masters in Management" and 7th worldwide in "International Career Mobility" rankings by the Financial Times in 2015.

### **PROGRAMME STRUCTURE**

This is a full-time, demanding degree which is approached from an international perspective. The programme's content is built on relevant and up-to-date core management courses and cross-functional approaches in order to fulfil the demand for first-class international and global managers.

The MIB programme is studied over two years, with the second year entirely devoted to the completion of the final management project (FMP). The FMP can be completed in parallel with an internship or full-time employment.

### **CLASS PROFILE**


The GGSB MIB welcomes future business leaders from around the world, providing a global experience from the moment you arrive. The average age of the 2014 class\*\* was 22 years old.
